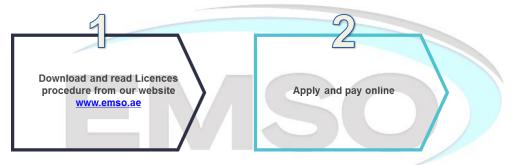
Overview

- The EMSO is the representative organization of international governing bodies the FIA and FIM and as such, is the only body in the UAE allowed to issue licenses to both, competitors and officials.
- -To compete in UAE motorsport, you will need an EMSO Competitor Licence.
- -There are various different Licence types and grades within those Licence types, so you need to make sure you know which one you need before applying for it.

All EMSO competition and officials' licenses include personal accident insurance.

How to apply for a Competitor's Licence?

- 1- An applicant should read this licencing Procedure and complete online licence application form provided on EMSO website www.emso.ae.
- An applicant Should download the supporting documents (if needed) like medical test form.
- 3- Apply online



EMSO Issues soft copies for all national licences and both, soft and hard copies for international licences.

NOC(Important note):

As per the regulations, EMSO should send an NOC request to the competitors' parent ASN who in return should give us their prior agreement to the issuing of licenses (FIA ISC 9.3.2).

MEDICAL TEST:

- Medical test must be completed by every competitor each year for all those applying for INTERNATIONAL LICENCES ONLY.
- ❖ The medical visit must have been carried out by a doctor of medicine authorized to practice in the UAE which issues the LLicence, less than 3 months before the application for a driver's Licence is submitted. (FIA-ISC-APENDIX L –ART.1).

The medical test should include ECG report every two years:

If you are 45 years and OVER:

- A Stress Related ECG is required for ANY International Licence if you are aged 45 years or OVER
- The report MUST be signed by a Consultant Cardiologist, and must be clearly stated as so
- The reports MUST state that it has been performed to either the Bruce Protocol treadmill test, or the Ergometric Bicycle test
- We only require the full written report from the Consultant Cardiologist (please do not send the trace)

If you are UNDER 45 years:

A Resting ECG is required for ANY International Licence if you are UNDER the age of 45.

❖ To apply for licence, kindly read below details FIRST and then apply online through:

Online Applications for Entrant, Competitor, Instructor Licences and to upgrade existing valid licences – Emirates Motorsports Organization (emso.ae).

VALIDITY OF LICENCE:

• Licences shall expire on the 31st of December each year (ART 9.3 ISC).

FIA Licenses- (Auto licences)

When processing an FIA (or karting) Licence application for all non-Emirati Nationals, the EMSO must first gain approval from that competitor's home ASN, irrespective of whether they have ever held a Licence in that country (FIA ISC 3.9.4b)

For all FIA licenses, a valid passport, Emirates ID and visa (excluding UAE nationals) must be supplied each year.

All FIA competitors' licenses must start with Axx xxx (A for Auto).

1-Novice - Restricted:

Price – AED 350.

Required for Auto tests and basic circuit events. (Time attack and Autocross events).

Required Documents:

- Online Application form which includes self-declaration form.
- Passport copy
- UAE VISA copy (excluding UAE nationals) (excluding UAE nationals)
- Emirates ID copy

Minimum age: 16 years old.

2-Circuit National:

Price – AED 800.

Required for Circuit National level events in the UAE.

Required Documents:

- Online Application form which includes self-declaration form.
- Passport copy
- UAE VISA copy (excluding UAE nationals).
- Emirates ID copy.

Additional Documents:

For the first time must be present assessment test certificate showing that competitors have completed the appropriate introductory training from either Dubai Autodrome or Yas Marina Circuit.

Minimum age: 16 years old.

3-Circuit National Junior:

Price – AED 750.

Required for Circuit National level events in the UAE. Max 2.5kg/1hp power to weight ratio and max 200hp at crankshaft and must be single make/model race series

Required Documents:

- Online Application form which includes self-declaration form.
- Passport copy
- ❖ UAE VISA copy (excluding UAE nationals).
- Emirates ID copy.
- ❖ Applicants must hold a National Kart licence .
- Parent confirmation letter and school letter.

Additional Documents:

For the first time must be present assessment test certificate showing that competitors have completed the appropriate introductory training from either Dubai Autodrome or Yas Marina Circuit.

Age: 15 to 16 years old.

4- Circuit International Grade D (ITC-D) (ART 8 APPENDIX L ISC)

Price – AED 1450.

Required for all circuit cars with a weight/power ratio greater than 3 kg/hp. Single-Seaters, GT, Touring Cars, Autocross (except Autocross Super Buggy), Rallycross (except Super Cars), Trucks (except FIA Trucks) and Drifting, or equivalent categories Historic cars racing in circuit events (except those mentioned in Article 8.1a)

Required Documents:

- Online Application form.
- ❖ Medical test. (You can download medical test form from our website).
- Passport copy.
- UAE VISA copy.
- Emirates ID copy.
- Online Anti-doping certificate if the applicant applies for the first (please reupload it if you already have it). To apply for it kindly visit: https://adel.wadaama.org/learn/public/learning_plan/view/1/international-level-athletes-educationprogram-english.
- ❖ FIA E-learning certificate: Drivers applying for an IT C-C licence for the first time must have undergone FIA e-learning safety training for Circuits. Minimum age: 16 years old.

- The driver must be observed to compete to the satisfaction of the licencing ASN in at least five ASN-sanctioned competitions, as specified in Article 1.9 FIA Appendix L.
- For the avoidance of doubt, the licencing ASN should request a report from the Host ASN of the competition should it not be sanctioned by the licencing ASN.

5- Circuit International Grade C (ITC-C) (ART 8 APPENDIX L ISC)

Price - AED 1650.

Required for all circuit cars with a weight/power ratio of between 2 and 3 kg/hp Single-Seater, Prototype, GT, Touring Car, FIA Autocross Super Buggy, FIA Rallycross Super Car and FIA Truck Championships, or equivalent categories. Historic Formula One cars (Period G onwards), Formula Two cars (Period H onwards), Indy Cars (Period G onwards), Formula 5000 and Formula A cars (all), Group C cars (all), CanAm cars (all), and Sports Prototypes over 2 litres (Period G onwards) regardless of weight/power ratio.

Qualification criteria

Applicants must hold an International Grade E or D-C licence or a National Licence of similar grade. The driver must be observed to compete satisfactorily to the satisfaction of the licencing ASN, in competitions as specified in Article 1.9, within the two years prior to application:

a) with an ITD-C licence, in at least five ASN sanctioned circuit competitions

Or

b) with an ITE licence, in at least ten ASN sanctioned circuit competitions

Or

c) with a National licence of equivalent grade, in at least ten ASN-sanctioned competitions,

(Minimum of five circuit competitions).

Competitions in Karting, Single-Seaters, GT, Touring Cars, Autocross, Rallycross, Historic circuit and Trucks, or equivalent (except Drifting). Any competitions in other disciplines cannot be considered.

For the avoidance of doubt, the licencing ASN should request a report from the Host ASN of the competition should it not be sanctioned by the

6- Circuit International grade B (ITB):

Price – AED 3500.

Required for International events worldwide.

Required for all cars with a weight/power ratio of between 1 and 2 kg/hp Single-Seaters, Prototypes, GT and Touring Cars, or equivalent categories

Grade A or B licences are issued by the driver's ASN, after it has verified that the driver's results, competence and conduct are satisfactory.

- Medical test. (You can download medical test form from our website)
- Passport copy.
- UAE VISA copy.
- Emirates ID copy.

Minimum age: 16 years old.

Qualification criteria

Applicants must hold an International Grade C-C licence.

The driver must be observed to compete to the satisfaction of the licencing ASN, in at least five ASN-sanctioned circuit competitions within the two years prior to application. Should the two-year period include 2020 or 2021, then the three years prior to application should be considered instead.

Competitions for Single-Seaters, Prototypes, GT or Touring Cars, where the minimum licence required is an IT C-C. Any competitions in other disciplines cannot be considered.

For the avoidance of doubt, the EMSO should request a report from the Parent ASN of the competition should it not be sanctioned by the EMSO.

Renewal or expiry:

In order to maintain the qualification for a Grade B licence, the driver must participate in at least one international competition of the appropriate category per 12-month period, or otherwise must again be observed, to the satisfaction of the licensing ASN, during practice for an international competition. Should the 12-month period include the year 2020 or 2021, then the 24-months prior to application should be considered.

7-Circuit International A:

Price - AED 6300.

Required for International events worldwide

Required for all cars with a weight/power ratio less than or equal to 1 kg/hp. Single-Seaters, Prototypes or equivalent categories

Required Documents:

- Online Application form.
- Medical test. (You can download medical test form from our website)
- Passport copy.
- UAE VISA copy.
- Emirates ID copy.

Minimum age: 17 years old.

Qualification criteria

- The driver must be the holder of a current FIA International Grade B licence
- The driver must have completed six events in Grade C Championships;

<u>Maintain:</u> To maintain the licence after the first year, the competitor must enter at least one international event over the previous 12 months.

Minimum age: 17 years old.

8-Rally National:

Price – AED 750.

Required for National rally level in the UAE.

Required Documents:

- Online Application form which includes self-declaration form .
- Passport copy
- UAE VISA copy (excluding UAE nationals).
- Emirates ID copy.

Minimum age: 16 years old.

9-Rally National junior:

Price – AED 630.

National Rallies, Rally Cross (Not valid for stage or cross-country rally without a driver or co-driver 18years +

max3kg/1hp and max 100hp engine

Required Documents:

- Online Application form which includes self-declaration form.
- Passport copy
- UAE VISA copy (excluding UAE nationals).
- Emirates ID copy.
- Parent confirmation letter and school letter.

Age: 13 to 16 years old.

10-Rally International Grade D (ITD-R):

Price - AED 1750.

Required for all International level rallies.

Required for all road cars with a weight/power ratio greater than 5 kg/hp

Required for all road cars with a weight/power ratio greater than 5 kg/hp Sporting Rally cars (Rally3, Rally4, Rally5), Cross Country cars (except T1), or equivalent categories Hill Climb cars, except for cars in Groups CN, D and E2 of Category II as defined in Article 251.1.1 of the FIA Appendix J (W/P ratio not applicable).

Required for all road cars with a weight/power ratio greater than 5 kg/hp Sporting Rally cars (Rally3, Rally4, Rally5), Cross Country cars (except T1), or equivalent categories Hill Climb cars, except for cars in Groups CN, D and E2 of Category II as defined in Article 251.1.1 of the FIA Appendix J (W/P ratio not applicable).

For the avoidance of doubt, the licencing ASN should request a report from the Host ASN of the competition should it not be sanctioned by the licencing ASN.

12-Drag National:

Price – AED 750.

Required for Drag National level events, both in the UAE and abroad.

Required Documents:

- Online Application form which includes self-declaration form .
- Passport copy
- ❖ UAE VISA copy (excluding UAE nationals).
- Emirates ID copy.

Minimum age: 16 years old

13-Drag International:

Price - AED 1450.

Required for all International level drag events

12-Drift National A: (PRO)

Price – AED 750.

FIA Karting Licences

The **National** Karting licenses issued to those over 5 years old.

The **International** FIA Karting licenses can only be issued to those over the age of 11.

All 2023 FIA Karting licenses must begin with K YY XXX (K for Kart). The EMSO produces 6 different types of Karting Licence:

- Emirates ID copy
- School letter (for those below 16) confirming that competitors are in full time education.

Minimum age: 14 years old

Kart International Grade G (ITG):

Price – AED 1200.

Required for and limited to Karting OK Junior, Autocross Junior and XC-Junior, or equivalent categories.

Age criteria:

Drivers aged between 11 (reaching their 11th birthday before 1 January of the year of participation) and 14 (reaching their 14th birthday during the calendar year of participation).

Required Documents:

- Online Application form
- Medical test .
- Passport copy
- UAE VISA copy for non-Emiratis
- Emirates ID copy
- School letter confirming that they are in full time education .

For the first time:

Upgrade Conditions (article 3.3 appendix L)

- 1-Competitors must already be the holder of a kart national licence.
- 2-The competitor must then produce evidence that they have started (5 national level races) For each race, the form must be signed by the appropriate CoC or ASN Steward.

<u>Medical:</u> An annual medical must be completed by all competitors (you can find medical test form and download it from our website).

A Driver's weight (including the Driver's equipment) must be a minimum of 35 kg at all times during a competition

Kart International Grade F (ITF):

Price - AED 1200.

Required for and limited to Karting OK Senior (only non-gearbox categories), Autocross Junior and XC-Junior, or equivalent categories.

Age criteria:

Drivers aged between 13 (reaching their 13th birthday before 1 January of the year of participation) and 15 (reaching their 15th birthday during the calendar year of participation).

Required Documents:

- Online Application form
- Passport copy
- Medical test
- UAE VISA copy for non-Emiratis
- Emirates ID copy
- Parent confirmation letter and School letter confirming that they are in full time education.

For the first time:

- 1-Competitors must already be the holder of a kart national licence or ITG licence.
- 2-The competitor must then produce evidence that they have started (5 national level races) For each race, the form must be signed by the appropriate CoC or ASN Steward.

<u>Medical:</u> An annual medical must be completed by all competitors (you can find medical test form and download it from our website).

A Driver's weight (including the Driver's equipment) must be a minimum of 40 kg at all times during a competition

Kart International Grade E (ITE):

Price – AED 1200.

Age criteria:

Drivers aged 14 (reaching their 14th birthday before 1 January of the year of participation).

Their preferred module and language version can be selected after sign-in

<u>Upgrade Conditions</u> (article 3.3 appendix L)

- 1- Applicants must hold an International Grade F or G licence or a National licence of similar grade.
- 2- The driver must be observed to compete to the satisfaction of the licencing ASN in at least five ASN-sanctioned competitions, as specified in Article 1.9. appendix L ISC FIA. For each race, the form must be signed by the appropriate CoC or ASN Steward.

<u>Medical:</u> An annual medical must be completed by all competitors (you can find medical test form and download it from our website).

A Driver's weight (including the Driver's equipment) must be a minimum of 35 kg at all times during a competition

When processing an EMSO Moto/ FIM licence application for all non-Emirati Nationals, the EMSO must first gain approval from that competitors home Federation, the NOC.

Note about Moto and FIM single event:

There is a different procedure regarding FIM international licenses. A rider wishing to compete in an international event (listed on the FIM international calendar), must also apply, through the EMSO, for an FIM One Event or Annual licence.

All 2023 Moto Licenses must begin with MXX XXX (M for Motorcycles).

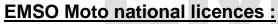

Entrants Licences

An entrant licence is required when a team wishes to officially enter an event, and have their name printed in the official entry list and results. The EMSO only issues Entrants licenses for FIA and FIA Karting, as the FIM operates under a different procedure.

Requirements:

- ❖ An application form containing the teams name, contact phone number, what type of licence they require, and a signature.
- Team Logo

There are 3 different types of Entrant Licence:

Entrant National – Valid for a complete year of national level racing. Cost is AED 1000.

Entrant International – Valid for a complete year of international level racing. Cost is AED 5000, and the team is entitled to 3 copies of the licence.

Entrant International (Single Event) – Valid for only a single international meeting. Cost is AED 1000. The specific meeting should be named on the licence to prevent it being reused.
